# (U) Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) Report, 15 October–12 November 2025

**14 NOVEMBER 2025** 

## (U) Executive Summary

#### (U) Scope

(U) The Worldwide Threat to Shipping (WTS) report provides information on threats to merchant vessels, the shipping industry, and other maritime stakeholders worldwide in the last 30 days. This report is produced primarily to inform merchant mariners and naval forces.

(U) Warnings, Advisories and Alerts: See Appendix C for active advisories.

#### (U) Summary:

- 1. GULF OF GUINEA: On 07 November, a Netherlands-flagged cargo ship was attacked by pirates transiting in the Gulf of Guinea.
- 2. SOMALIA: On 07 November, a Marshall Islands-flagged LNG tanker had suspicious activity near the vessel.
- 3. SOMALIA: On 06 November, a Malta-flagged tanker was attacked by pirates.

(U) This section lists reports of active violence against shipping, credible threats to shipping, or the potential for a situation to develop into a direct threat to shipping over the past 30 days. Every effort is made to ensure that incidents are not double-counted. In the event that double-counting is detected, or an incident is later found to be different than initially reported, an explanation of the cancellation of the inaccurate report will be made in at least one message prior to dropping the erroneous report.

#### (U) WEST AFRICA – GULF OF GUINEA



- (U) GULF OF GUINEA: On 07 November, a Netherlands-flagged cargo ship was attacked by pirates. The crew members escaped kidnapping by barricading themselves in the citadel. The pirates entered and searched the ship. A security team from Cameroon later came to the crews aid and found the ship abandoned by the pirates. (Vesseltracker/Clearwater Dynamics)
- 2. (U) GHANA: On 30 October, a Panama-flagged Ro-Ro vessel was boarded while underway to Terma Pilot Station. It has been reported that the Ghanaian Navy dispatched a patrol boat before intercepting and boarding the vessel. Ten perpetrators were located and detained. (IMB/Closed, Clearwater Dynamics)
- (U) NIGERIA: On 20 October 2025 at 0250 local time, an attempted robbery occurred on a
  container vessel whilst underway in Lagos Anchorage, Nigeria. One robber attempting to
  board the container ship was spotted by duty crew, which resulted in the perpetrator
  escaping. (Clearwater Dynamics, IMB)
- 4. **(U) ANGOLA**: On 16 October 2304 local time, a robbery occurred on a Liberia-flagged tanker whilst at anchor in Luanda Anchorage, Angola. Reports state that two perpetrators boarded



the vessel via the forecastle. The crew spotted the perpetrators and raised the alarm, causing the perpetrators to escape the vessel with the ship's stores. (Clearwater Dynamics, IMB)

#### (U) INDIAN OCEAN - EAST AFRICA - RED SEA



(U) SOMALIA: On 07 November, it has been reported that there was a suspicious approach
to a Marshall Islands-flagged LNG tanker. A small craft with three persons onboard came to
within 2nm of the vessel before returning to a suspected mothership. (Clearwater
Dynamics)

#### NAVAL INTELLIGENCE

- (U) SOMALIA: On 06 November, it has been reported that a Malta-flagged tanker was under attack southeast of Hobyo, Somalia. One craft with armed perpetrators approached and fired shots at the tanker. It has been reported that as well as small arms fire, the pirates fired RPGs towards the vessel and the pirates boarded. (CLOSED/Clearwater Dynamics/NAVEUR/UKMTO)
- (U) SOMALIA: On 28 October, the Puntland Police Forces reported two Iranian dhows were engaged by a Somalian group. One dhow has been seized by the authorities, the second dhow has evaded capture and remains unlocated. (Clearwater Dynamics, UKMTO/Closed)
- 4. (U) YEMEN: On 18 October at 0945 local time, a Cameroon-flagged LPG tanker was struck by an unknown projectile, causing a fire onboard. Of the 26 crew members, 24 evacuated into life rafts, while two remained onboard. A Botswana-flagged tanker diverted to provide assistance and subsequently rescued the 24 crew members, heading towards Djibouti. The explosion was deemed accidental with no external cause, two crew members have lost their lives. (Clearwater Dynamics, UKMTO/CLOSED)

#### (U) EAST ASIA - SOUTHEAST ASIA

(U) SINGAPORE STRAIT: On 16 October 0340 local time, an attempted robbery onboard a
Cyprus-flagged bulk carrier while underway in the Eastbound Lane of the Traffic Separation
Scheme of the Phillip Channel. Reports state that the crew spotted two perpetrators. All
crew have been reported as safe, and nothing was reported stolen. (Clearwater Dynamics,
IFC)

## (U) Appendix B: Definitions

- (U) In order to promote consistent use of accurate terms of reference, we use the following definitions to describe a range of criminal antishipping activity and impediments to safe navigation in our worldwide reporting and analysis.
  - > (U) **Attempted Boarding** Close approach or hull-to-hull contact with report that boarding paraphernalia were employed or visible in the approaching boat.
  - > (U) Blocking Hampering safe navigation, docking, or undocking of a vessel as a means of protest.
  - > (U) Boarding Unauthorized embarkation of a vessel by persons not part of its complement without successfully taking control of the vessel.
  - > (U) Fired Upon Weapons discharged at or toward a vessel.
  - > (U) Hijacking Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement.
  - > (U) Kidnapping Unauthorized forcible removal of persons belonging to the vessel from it.
  - > (U) Hijacking/Kidnapping Combination Unauthorized seizure and retention of a vessel by persons not part of its complement who forcefully remove crew members from vessel when disembarking.
  - > (U) Robbery Theft from a vessel or from persons aboard the vessel.
  - > (U) Suspicious Approach All other unexplained activity in close proximity of an unknown vessel.
