Captain Scott Chesbrough assumed the duties of ONI Chief of Staff in June 2018 after serving as the Assistant Deputy Director for Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Operations, J-32, the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

Prior to his Joint Staff assignment, CAPT Chesbrough served as Commanding Officer of the Kennedy Irregular Warfare Center from 2015–2017. He previously served as head of the Naval Warfare Department in the Nimitz Operational Intelligence Center.

CAPT Chesbrough was assigned to the Chief of Naval Operations Staff from 2011–2014 where he conducted analysis and assessments in the Naval Warfare Integration office (NOOX), served as an Action Officer in the Warfare Integration office (N9I), and was the Executive Assistant to the Assistant Deputy Director of Naval Intelligence and the Director of Intelligence Operations.

CAPT Chesbrough graduated with merit from the United States Naval Academy in 1992 with a Bachelor of Science in Political Science. His first operational tour was aboard USS *John Young* (DD 973) as the Communications Officer and Navigator from 1992–1996. At the end of his tour, he transferred to the Intelligence Community where his first assignments were at the Joint Intelligence Center Pacific as watch officer, command briefer and submarine analyst, and Tactical Training Group Pacific as an instructor.

From 2002–2004, CAPT Chesbrough was assistant N2 for Carrier Strike Group 2 (CSG-2) aboard USS Harry S. Truman (CVN 75) where he supported Commander Task Force 60 combat operations during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

CAPT Chesbrough was assigned as a collection manager to the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) Defense Intelligence Operations Coordination Center from 2006–2009. During this tour, he also served on the Collection staff of the Director of National Intelligence, supporting senior policy makers. From 2009–2011, he served as N2 for Expeditionary Strike Group 3 (ESG-3) and he completed an Individual Augmentee deployment to ESG-5 in Bahrain.

CAPT Chesbrough graduated from the Naval War College, receiving a Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies and completed the Armed Forces Staff College in 2006. He is a Joint Qualified Officer.
